### Jacques Vigner Elected Chairman of AMAFI

**The Board of the French Financial Markets Association (AMAFI) elected Jacques Vigner as Chairman of the Association on 2 July 2026.**

He succeeds Stéphane Giordano, who had served as Chairman since October 2014. Mr Giordano will remain a member of the AMAFI Board and has been appointed Honorary Chairman in recognition of his commitment and his contribution to the Association's development.

A Managing Director at BNP Paribas Financial Markets SNC, Jacques Vigner is also a member of the Executive Committee of Global Markets, BNP Paribas, where he serves as Chief Strategic Oversight Officer.

A graduate of the École Polytechnique and the École des Mines, he has more than 25 years' experience in the financial markets industry. Throughout his career, he has held a wide range of responsibilities in derivatives, risk management, strategy and the transformation of market activities, giving him extensive expertise in the sector's key challenges.

Jacques Vigner said: "AMAFI plays an essential role in representing financial market participants and supporting the major transformations taking place across our industry. I would like to thank Stéphane Giordano for his leadership of the Association over the past twelve years. Through his commitment, he has strengthened AMAFI's position in the European policy debate and helped develop the Association to support market activities during a period of profound change, particularly following Brexit. I am honoured to succeed him and to continue, together with all the members of the Board, the work undertaken in the service of the French financial marketplace, promoting competitive and attractive financial markets capable of providing sustainable financing for our economy."

The Board also re-elected Vincent Remy, Adviser to the Chairman of Viel & Cie, as Vice-Chairman of the Association. Mr Remy notably chaired the working group responsible for the introduction of the euro in the French government bond market. He subsequently oversaw products and indices at the Paris Bourse (SBF), which later became Euronext. He also served as Chairman of STOXX before taking responsibility for Euronext-Liffe's equity derivatives and indices business.
